

## **Volunteer Driver Guidelines City Tree Christian School**

Persons who volunteer to provide transportation for First Presbyterian Church or City Tree Christian School students to church or school scheduled activities must:

- 1. Be at least 21 years of age and have a current driver's license. No more than one moving vehicle violation in past 3 years.
- 2. File a copy of current proof of liability insurance (100,000/300,000 minimum) and valid driver's license, together with this signed a document, with the church or school office prior to the event.
- 3. Be certain that the vehicle to be used is road-worthy and has a current registration.
- 4. Make certain that the number of occupants does not exceed the number for which the vehicle was designed.
- 5. See that all occupants, including the driver, use safety belts and if necessary a car seat (if child is younger than 6 years old or weighs < 60lbs).
- 6. No child under the age of 12 may ride in a seat with an airbag.
- 7. If possible, travel caravan-style when more than one vehicle is used for a trip.
- 8. Driver will follow all applicable laws and commit to avoid use of cell phone or other distracting activities while driving.
- 9. Driver will have emergency contact information for passengers and parent permission slips as appropriate.
- 10. I understand that my personal Automobile Liability Insurance is considered the primary insurance in the event of a loss and that the church automobile liability insurance is secondary.
